Percent with Complete COS data entered as of 7/11/12.

Children that exited B23 between 7/1/11 and 6/30/12 with at least 6 months between the 1st service and B23 exit date. Exit reasons for this are only No Longer Eligible/Completion of IFSP before 3 or any of the 4 reasons at age 3. These should all be close to 100% since Parent Withdrawing and Moves are not counted.
