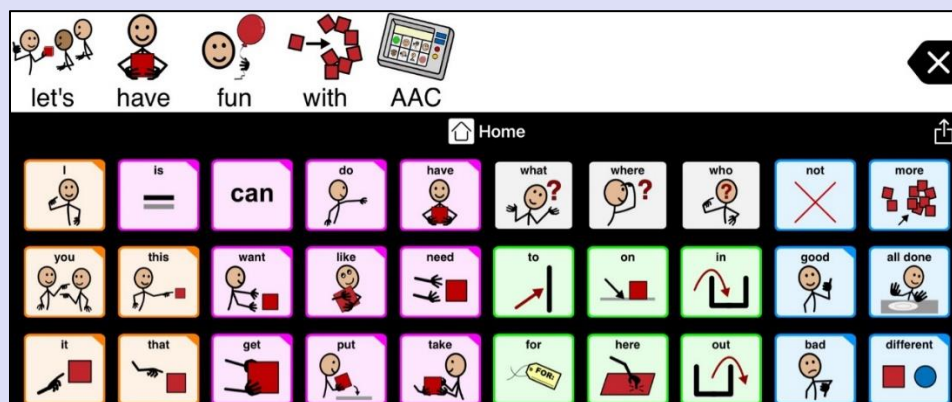


You're Invited to AAC Summer Bash!

FAQs:

Who can attend the event?

Is there an age limit for participants?

- No, there is not a set age limit; however, we anticipate most participants will be school-aged.

Is the event space accessible?

- Yes, the Camp Hemlocks location is accessible and can accommodate adaptive equipment such as wheelchairs and walkers.

Can my child participate if he/she does not have an AAC device?

- Yes, we will have lite-tech (paper-based) AAC core communication boards available.

I can't attend the whole time. Can I still register?

- Yes! We would be happy to have you join us even if you can't be there from 10-2.

Will medical care be provided if needed?

- We will have basic first aid available, but a nurse will not be on site. Please come equipped with any and all medical care that you need.
