New Trauma ScreenTIME  
Early Childhood Course  
Now Available Nationwide



**The Trauma ScreenTIME Early Childhood Course is an online training course on how to screen young children (ages 0-6) for trauma.**

The self-paced course is intended for anyone who works with young children, including **classroom teachers, home visitors, clinicians, and others**. It was developed by the Child Health and Development Institute (CHDI) in collaboration with families and national experts based on current research and best practices.

The course provides staff working with young children the knowledge to effectively screen for trauma and connect families with their preferred supports and services to help children recover from the effects of trauma exposure.

Topics covered include:

- The importance of screening for trauma and traumatic stress
- Common questions about trauma screening
- Developing a screening process for your setting
- Selecting a screening measure
- Conducting screening and discussing results with families
- Using the results of screening to help children and families

3. **Trauma ScreenTIME Pediatric Primary Care Course** - For staff working in pediatric primary care settings

Courses specific to child welfare and juvenile justice are planned for the future; however, staff in those settings can currently take the Core Course.
