- ◆ Evaluations and visits can be completed successfully using Remote Early Intervention (EI), which is phone interviews and video communication.

- ◆ Children currently enrolled in Birth to Three and turning three soon may be eligible for continued services during the COVID-19 emergency. Families should speak to their Service Coordinator about "Over 3" to learn more.
